Pure Comedic Fantasy – The Xanth Series







KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES


- What unique knowledge skills or abilities do you have? Here are some of mine that became realities:

• Lillian Jackson Braun, another Mystery Writer, loves Cats. She created the popular "The Cat Who..." series.






How about Articles and Short Stories?

- People who work with the Blind


