Result: Writes a book


KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES





• Lillian Jackson Braun, another Mystery Writer, loves Cats. She created the popular "The Cat Who..." series.






AN ANTHOLOGY BY THE CORRALES WRITING GROUP

Victory from the Shadows appeals to:


- New Mexico History Buffs
